

### **Spring Term Schedule Update**

Spring Term schedules will primarily stay the same. Students who have indicated that they want to remain in distance learning will join classes virtually when we are able to transition to in-person classes. Given the wide variety of requests, this is the best way to provide access to both virtual and in-person learning. We will share more information when we get closer to a transition point. As a reminder, the high schools cannot transition to hybrid classes until the county has been in the Red Tier for at least 14 consecutive days and the district has determined it is time to return according to the LTUSD Pandemic Plan.
