STHS GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- ★ 4 CLASSES OF ENGLISH (pass Sr. Project)
- ★ 3 CLASSES OF MATH (must pass Algebra or HS Math I)
- ★ 6 CLASSES OF SOCIAL SCIENCE
- ★ 2 CLASSES OF SCIENCE(life/physical)
- ★ 2 CLASSES OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION
- ★ 1 CLASS OF VISUAL/PERFORMING ART OR LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH
- ★ 9 CLASSES OF ELECTIVES = 250 CREDITS
- ★ MUST PASS ALL CLASSES WITH A “D-” OR HIGHER

FALL JUNIOR YEAR CREDIT STATUS

- ✦ 20 credits times 4 semesters in 9th grade = 80 credits possible
- ✦ 20 credits times 4 semesters in 10th grade = 80 credits possible

IF YOU CURRENTLY HAVE **LESS THAN 100 CREDITS OR ARE SUBJECT DEFICIENT**, YOU NEED TO SEE YOUR COUNSELOR FOR AN ACADEMIC REVIEW ASAP!!

- ✦ Must be 18 yrs. old or HS graduate
- ✦ No entrance exams for admission
- ✦ Offer AA/ AS degrees and Certificates
- ✦ Credit for AP exams scores of 3+
- ✦ Free application, no essay, no tests
- ✦ Low fees for CA residents
- ✦ Many degrees and certificates

COMMUNITY COLLEGE

- ✦ Transfer: where do LTCC students go?
- ✦ Why attend a Community College prior to transferring?
- ✦ Numerous Transfer Options: CSU Option: AA-T/AS-T transfer degrees

- ★ ELIGIBILITY IN LOCAL CONTEXT (top 9% from each HS determined during admission/ comprehensive review)

COLLEGE ENTRANCE TESTS

- ★ SAT Test (\$64.50) or ACT with writing (\$67.00) required by CSU, UC and most private schools.
- ★ SAT Subject Tests for some private schools; tests are suggested for STEM majors.
- ★ TOEFL for foreign or qualified ELD students
- ★ See flyer for dates if interested.

JUNIORS: Take one of each test this spring and again in the fall if necessary. Don't wait until senior year!!! STUDY!!
