School Attire

School attire should foster a safe and positive educational environment for our students. All students are to attend school and school-related activities dressed in a manner which is clean and appropriate for the health and safety of themselves and of others and supports the educational process.

Allowable Attire

- Students must wear clothing including both a shirt with pants or skirt, or the equivalent and shoes.
- Clothing must cover undergarments, waistbands and bra straps excluded.
- All private parts must be covered by fabric that is not see-through.
- Students' faces and ears must be visible to staff at all times. Headwear must not interfere with the line of sight to any student or staff.
- Clothing must be suitable for all scheduled school activities including physical education, science labs, wood shop, and other activities where unique hazards exist.
- Specialized courses and activities may require or allow specialized attire, such as sports uniforms or safety gear.
- Shirts must be worn to reach the top of student's pants, shorts or skirt.

Non-permissible Attire

- Attire depicting, advertising or advocating the use of alcohol, tobacco, marijuana or other controlled substances.
- Attire depicting pornography, nudity, partial nudity, sexual acts, or expletives.
- Attire, including gang identifiers, that threatens the health or safety of any other student or staff.
- Attire depicting hate speech targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious affiliation or any other protected groups.
