SOPHOMORE COURSE REQUEST 2019-2020

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 250 credits and passing High School Math I, and senior project are required to graduate. A student should have completed ninth grade course requirements by August 2019, or will need to repeat any courses that are required to graduate if failed the previous year.
- Sophomores must enroll in eight (8) classes for the year (4 per term).
- From the required courses listed below, select one (1) course in each subject: English, World History, math, science and P.E. and circle the appropriate course number. You will be placed according to grades, test scores, benchmark assessments and teacher recommendation.
- From the course offering sheet, select three (3) elective courses of your choice. Place the course number and course title in the spaces provided for the electives below. Select alternates in order of preference. Alternates are used for scheduling conflicts. (p) indicates college prep and H indicates an Honors course.
