FRESHMAN COURSE REQUEST 2019-2020

INSTRUCTIONS:

- All students must earn 250 credits in required subjects and pass High School Math I and senior project in order to graduate.
- Freshmen must enroll in eight (8) classes for the year; English, math, health/CCC 10 Year Plan, geography, PE I, science and two electives. Some electives are offered on a yearlong A/B schedule.
- All course requests will be reviewed for appropriate placement based on grades, test scores, benchmark assessments and teacher input.
- Once you have selected your two (2) electives from the elective choices, click on "Add Alternate" directly across from the elective you chose, and add the course you would like if your first choice is not available. If you have applied to AVID, check the box under Electives. (p) Indicates college prep.
