

On the attached paper, write **at least 100 words, but as many as you would like**. Write in full sentences in Spanish, NOT in English. Use and underline at least 20 different verbs in the past tense (either imperfect or preterite). Only underline the verb the FIRST time it appears. Only use present tense when you write the conversation quotes.

Here is what you need to include:

- Introduce a character using YOUR Spanish name.
- Tell the location where he/she lived. Make sure it is in Spanish if needed.
- Include any creative details about the main character, (but be careful of your grammar).
- Introduce a parallel character (friend or animal) that joins the main character for the adventure. Include why he/she is along for the adventure.
- Explain that there was a problem: the main character needed/wanted something (you choose).
- The main character went to a store or place to buy the item, but was not successful on the first attempt. Introduce another character that worked at that first location how he/she tried to help the main character. Include what he/she said or how he/she responded.
- At the second location, introduce another character that successfully resolves the main character's issue. Include what he/she said or how he/she responded.
- Use 2 or more quotes in a conversation with quotation marks using the present tense. (These verbs can count among your required 20 verb variation if not yet previously used.)
- Include how the main character reacted, and whether or not he/she liked the outcome.
- You must complete this and use this outline below to plan it out before you start writing. Write in English or Spanish. **Be sure to include at least the 20 verbs you include in your story.**
